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BACKGROUND

- Some of the most substantial opportunities for transformative care, quality improvement and research lie within **primary care**.
- Clinical research in primary care means that results are **more generalizable** to daily practice.
- ➤ Primary care practice-based learning and research networks are key building blocks for knowledge production, dissemination and practice improvement


CONTEXT

- > POPLAR is a provincial initiative started in 2021
- Funded by the Ministry of Health through provincial primary care research policy partnership INSPIRE-PHC
- Includes research, QI and EMR data
- Consists of PBLRNs from:
 - **➢ six** provincial **University Departments of Family Medicine**
 - ➤ the Alliance for Healthier Communities
 (Community Health Centres across province)

OBJECTIVES

- ➤ POPLAR's vision is to advance equitable primary healthcare delivery and health outcomes for everyone in Ontario, Canada
- Aim to achieve the Quintuple Aim, inclusive of Health Equity, through
 - A single provincial EMR data platform for data analytics
 - Processes and procedures to support Clinical Research and QI in practices



POPLAR DATA PLATFORM



- ➤ POPLAR EMR data is cleaned, deidentified and standardized.
- ➤ POPLAR studies can look at patient and practice data.
- Complies with robust ethics, governance and security measures.
- ➤ Individual patients have the **right to opt out** of their data being

 collected through POPLAR's

 networks

IMPLICATIONS for HEALTH SYSTEMS

- ➤ Ability to test initiatives in one POPLAR Network & scale up across province of Ontario
- Development of QI Dashboard, www.CareCanvas.ca, led by University of Toronto DFCM Quality & Innovations.
 - Feeds data back to physicians in a meaningful way
- ➤ POPLAR EMR data can provide
 - > Provincial and regional data reports
 - ➤ Planning information for Ontario Health Teams and health system
- ➤ EMR data will be **linked** with administrative data at ICES for health systems planning (early 2023)
- Data is only used for approved research projects
- ➤ POPLAR enables centralized coordination of clinical research projects in primary care practices across Ontario

FUTURE DIRECTIONS

- > Increase primary care provider participation across Ontario
- > Increase engagement with patients and communities
 - Patient Advisory Committee to begin meeting this fall
 - > Build relationships with Indigenous Partners
- > Continue to develop POPLAR infrastructure and processes
- ➤ Support the provincial roll-out of the CareCanvas QI Dashboard to all POPLAR members in early 2023
- Increase research in practices and QI activities
